#### 2. Report a fire

#### **Tel. 112 ... Fire service**

- WHERE is the fire?  
(73066 Uchingen, Maybachstraße 1)
- WHAT is on fire?
- Are people in danger?
- WHO is calling? (Say your name)

#### 3. Further actions to be taken

- leave the danger area
- help disabled persons
- DO NOT use elevators
- close windows and doors
- fight against the fire
- keep to the instructions of the fire service

## What to do in case of an emergency

### Keep calm!

#### 1. Report the accident!

- Call 112 immediately in case of emergency
- Inform first-aider

- Guide in the ambulance or fire service and send away onlookers

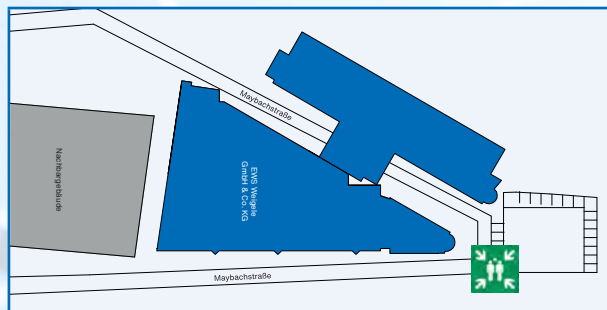

## SAFETY AT EWS

Safety rules apply for everybody.

### Dear visitor,

Your safety during your stay at EWS is very important to us therefore adhere to the following rules. Please only enter the production areas with your internal contact person. Please get in touch with your internal contact person when you enter or leave the premises. Visitor IDs must be worn visible. Get informed about danger and safety precautionary measures.

- Keep distance from all machines and stay on the marked paths.
- Safety shoes must be worn when carrying out work or when leaving the main route.
- For your own safety, do not touch anything, especially no machines and tools. This applies to production and stock.
- In all areas of the premises, attention must be paid to the risk posed by delivery and forklift traffic.

EWS staff instructions are to be obeyed.



The ban on smoking must be strictly adhered to in all rooms.



It is forbidden to take photographs or film recordings on the factory premises and in the company building.



Do not stay under overhead loads.



Elevators are only to be used for material transport (Exception only for people with disabilities).

If you have to stay near machines, please adhere to the following:



Machines can start at any time, please remain aloof.



The machine drives and the whole machinery possess high magnetic force, therefore please maintain a safety distance of one meter.



Adhere the safety distance of one meter. Particularly with regard to people with cardiac pacemakers and implants.



Do not carry magnetic cards or data media.
